Rick Scott & Nico Rhodes

PERFORMERS: Rick Scott – dulcimer, vocals, trombone
Nico Rhodes – electric piano, dulcimer, horns and vocals

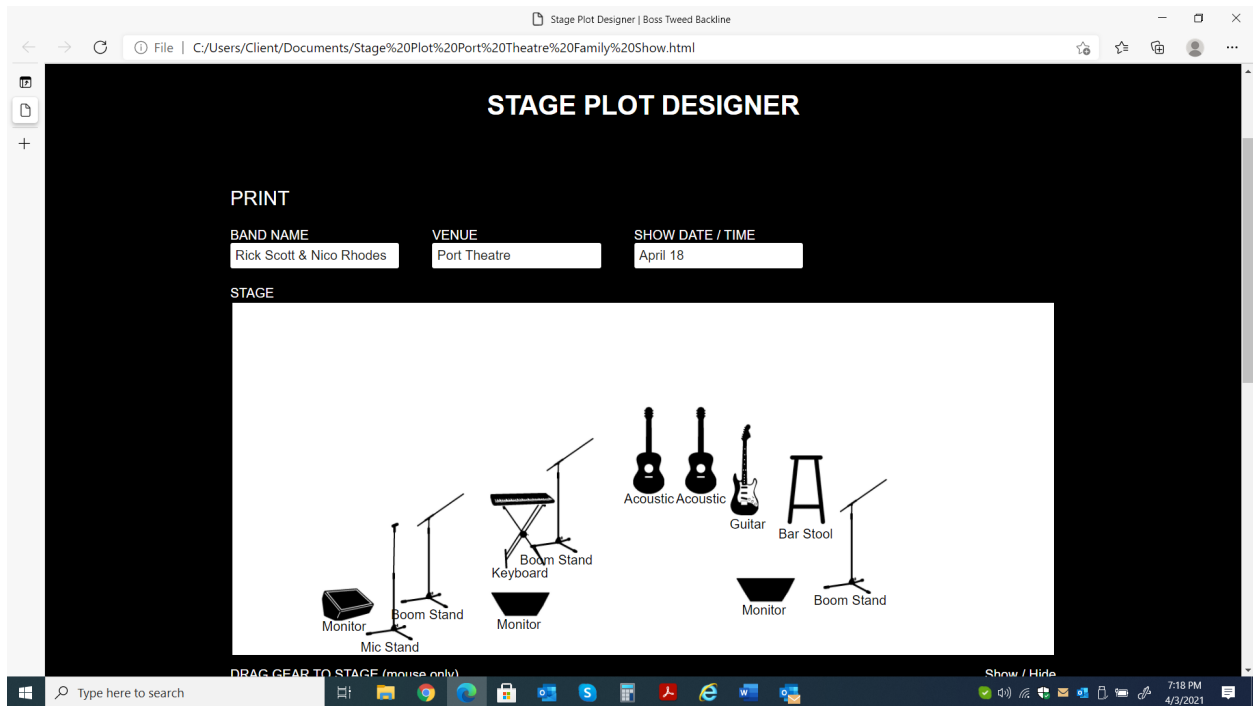

PRESENTER WILL PROVIDE:

- Professional sound and light systems with operators
- A digital electric piano: Roland RD 2000 or equivalent Yamaha P Series or Korg SV with full 88 weighted keys, 2 pedals, necessary cables and AC cord, a sturdy adjustable keyboard stand and adjustable bench.
NOTE: When travel allows, Nico will provide Roland RD 2000 digital electric piano and require an adjustable bench.
- Rick will bring wireless system for dulcimers and may provide own Shure 58s for CoVid protection.
- two D.I. (“Direct In”) XLR lines: one for Rick’s wireless vocal and dulcimer mics plus one for electric dulcimer
- two D.I. (“Direct In”) or 2 XLR for electric piano
- four SM 58 vocal mics, 3 on boom stands: one for Rick, one for Nico at piano and (if playing horns) one for Nico vocal at horn/dulcimer position downstage of electric piano; plus one for horn mic for saxophone.
- three stage monitors, powered or with amp, one upstage and one downstage of electric piano and one offset from centre to stage left
- electrical power to the stage area
- stool (approx. 36” in height)

LIGHTS: Simple fixed lighting is all that is required with spotlights focused on Rick centre stage and Nico in two positions seated at piano, and if playing horns (optional) in this show, standing to play horns and dulcimer downstage of the piano.

- 3 Electric Piano L
- 4 Electric Piano R
- 5 VOX Rick
- 6 VOX Nico Piano
- 7 VOX Nico Sax position
- 8 Horn Mic

NOTES

- Rick provides his own wireless dulcimer mic system
- Nico plays electric piano but may also play sax or play dulcimer and sing DS Right position
