A genuine passion for instruments and organology led him to put together a collection with over 200 pieces from afar and from various times.

As an artist, Cupeiro has created several notable projects. "Mythos" explores the musical heritage of ancient civilizations, while "Pangea" celebrates the diversity of world music. His "Forgotten Sounds" project focuses on reconstructing and playing rare instruments, breathing new life into historical musical wind instrument traditions.

Cupeiro's unique approach combines meticulous research with innovative performance techniques. He not only plays these instruments but also crafts many of them in his studio. His performances and recordings offer audiences a captivating journey through time and across cultures, showcasing the rich tapestry of human musical expression.
